What are the three laws of developmental direction? Germinal Period- Two-week period after conception, beginning with the establishment of the fertilized ovum (zygote) and ending with implantation of the blastula or blastocyst in the uterus. Embryonic period- 3rd through 8th week, beginning with implantation and ending when all of the basic bodily organs have developed. Fetal Period- 9th week until birth, beginning when all the bodily organs have developed and ending with birth.
